With origins believed to date back to the 1600's, this twin kiln oast and three stone barns were converted in the 1980's. Located on a country lane on the outskirts of Hawkhurst the oast enjoys views over the surrounding countryside.

The property forms a U-shape with flower and shrub borders edging the drive which leads to the double garage. The gardens of just under one acre, are laid predominantly to lawn with mature trees, flower and shrub beds. Stone paths lead around the garden. A stone terrace hosts a heated swimming pool and pool house. There are two greenhouses and a garden shed bordering a vegetable garden. There is also a pond.




