This delightful Grade II Listed village cottage is believed to date back to the 16th century and formed part of the Cloth Hall.

Exhibiting many period features, the accommodation consists of a double aspect sitting room with open fire and door to the garden, a dining room with fire place, a fitted kitchen with door to the courtyard and a family shower room on the ground floor. On the first floor there is a master bedroom with built in wardrobe, three further bedrooms, one with a pedestal wash basin, and a W.C.

Outside the cottage is approached through a wrought iron gate across a pretty paved garden with views across the church yard. A path leads to an enclosed garden to the side of the cottage which is laid to lawn with mature flower and shrub borders, a green house and a garden store. To the rear of the cottage there is a communal courtyard.


